Markham Liberty Square

Markham Liberty Square is a six-building complex located in the York region of the Greater Toronto Area. The first phase of the project is composed of approximately 26,477 m² of commercial/retail space in two buildings and four residential/mixed use towers with 600 units and two levels of underground parking spanning about 25,000 m². Markham Liberty Square is part of a 300-hectare build in the new Markham Centre that is based on "smart growth" principles. The majority of the concrete for Phase I will have been trucked from a Dufferin Concrete facility less than two kilometers away, thereby reducing the footprint on the environment.
